The government of Quebec has recently announced the modality of application of the vaccine passport in Quebec. The vaccine passport certifies that a person is adequately vaccinated against COVID-19. The Implementation will begin on September 1st and the vaccination passport will be necessary to obtain non-essential services in Quebec.

The FQSC and Cycling Canada have taken steps to obtain clarification as to the impact on our members when participating in sanctioned events. As of September 1st, the vaccination passport will be requested from all participants aged 13 and over during events in Quebec, regardless of the level of sanction or cycling discipline.

For athletes from outside Quebec, official proof of vaccination will be requested (double vaccination and/or second dose), in addition to photo ID. This validation will be done during the Riders confirmation and the Race Package Pickup (please consult the event technical guide).

Considering the fact that this is a new measure that must be adopted by decree of the Government of Quebec, an adaptation period is planned from September 1st to 15th, during which the vaccination passport will be deployed, without however sanction being applied.

Concretely, this means that the vaccination passport (Quebec's athletes) / proof of vaccination for athletes from other provinces) will be requested as of September 1st, but that it will nevertheless be possible for athletes who do not meet this requirement to take part in events until September 14th inclusively. After this date, it will be MANDATORY for all athletes to have their passport / proof of vaccination in order to take part in any event.

Those people involved in the organisation of events, i.e. members of the organizing committee, volunteers, marshals, coaches, mechanics and trainers, will not be subject to the passport / proof of vaccination.

It is also important to note that the vaccination passport will be required in the following places:

- bars and restaurants, including terraces;
- dining rooms of fast food establishments;
- Night Clubs
- microbreweries / distilleries;
- shopping center feeding areas;
